

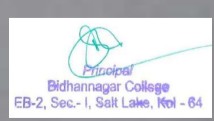

Online Workshop on Career Opportunities in Packaging 29.05.2021

An online workshop on Career Opportunities in Packaging was jointly organized by Placement and Career Counselling committee of Bidhannagar College in association with Indian Institute of Packaging, Kolkata centre on 29th May 2021 from 3 pm to 5.20 pm. More than 200 participants attended the workshop. There were considerable number of participants from Bidhannagar College from the Departments of Chemistry, Physics, Mathematics and Microbiology. Students from Departments of Statistics, Botany and Zoology also attended the workshop.

In the inaugural session of the workshop, the Officer-in-Charge of Bidhannagar College Mr. Tapomoy Das in his inaugural speech told that Packaging industry is fundamental to the participatory growth story of India as it stands today. In packaging, there is a passage from real need to the psychological need. Packaging essentially being transitory ensures the sustainability of the industry. It is also essential to every industry. The Director of Indian Institute of Packaging, Dr. Tanweer Alam also illuminated on the scope and necessity of the Packaging industry. He claimed 100 % placement after getting training in the Packaging Institute. Dr. Santanu Saha, Convener, Placement and Career Counselling committee, Bidhannagar College gave a warm welcome to the Director and Deputy Director of Indian Institute of Packaging.

Mr. Bidhan Das, Deputy Director, Indian Institute of Packaging, Kolkata centre was the speaker in the workshop. He started his lecture from 3.30 pm. Mr. Das explained the objectives of Packaging industry to the students. Indian Institute of Packaging (IIP), Kolkata was the head quarter of the Asian Packaging Federation twice. IIP is one of the members in World Packaging Industry. The aim of IIP is to increase the strength of the technical manpower through packaging education in India. IIP provides training and education as also research and development. The courses offered by IIP are two-year Post Graduate Diploma in Packaging (PGDP) which was started from 1985, 18 months Distance Education Programme, Intensive training course, Short term course, International training programme and National and International conferences. Mr. Das revealed the use of scientific materials and traditional materials in packaging industry in various fields. He also enlightened the students about the role of IIP as raw material manufacturer, packaging industry converter and packaging user industry. He also drew attention on ancillary packaging material. Food and pharmaceutical packaging are occupying 80% of packaging industry. Packaging industry is being considered as combination of arts, science, commerce, and technology which ensures safe delivery of products to consumer in sound condition at minimum overall cost. There are several levels of packaging like primary, secondary, and tertiary levels. He gave an idea about various symbols used in packaging and details of a proper label during packaging. He vividly described the curriculum of the two-year PGDP course and the job prospects in this field.

At the end of the presentation Mr. Bidhan Das invited questions from the students. Students from Department of Chemistry and Microbiology interacted with Mr. Das on various aspects of packaging as career option. The duration of the interaction was about 20 minutes.

This Workshop opened a new avenue before the students to pursue their career in the packaging industry.



Report on the Interactive Session conducted by State Bank of India (SBI), Salt Lake Branch jointly organized with Placement & Career Counselling Committee, Bidhannagar College on 02.12.2022 with a possibility of recruitment of students under State Bank Life Insurance

The session started at 3 pm in the Seminar Room of Bidhannagar College. From SBI, the Senior Divisional Manager (Marketing), the Development Manager (Marketing), the Assistant Branch Manager and Assistant Vice-President (L & D, Training) were there to give a Power Point Presentation. Around 40 students from various departments of the College along with some passed out students were present. The SBI officials gave details of the job scheme. Interested students (with minimum requirement of Higher Secondary or equivalent examination pass out degree) are to go through a 3 months' training named UTKARSH for boys and SHAKTI for girls, with a minimum of SBI Life Insurance procurement demand of Rs. 6 lakhs and 3 lakhs respectively. The trainees would get 10% of the total amount insured during this tenure. They would not pay any fees for this training. After fulfilling this criterion only, they would sit for an examination for joining the job, with a nominal amount of payment of fees. Initially the gross annual income will be around Rs. 3 lakhs. With time, they would be promoted to higher positions with higher pay scales as per norms. After joining the job, anybody may leave it any time if they find something better. It would be a permanent job, with pension scheme and medical benefits for family.

The duration of the presentation was around an hour, followed by 30 minutes' discussion session. Overall it was a very fruitful program for the students. The SBI team as well as the students were requested to inform about recruitment from our College, if there be any in near future. The SBI officials were also requested to come again to the College when the Job Window will be open next time.
