

As per her complaint, the incident has happened outside of the college campus, but as the alleged accused is the current student of the college, the ICC Committee members decided to hear from both the complainant (Swagata Sharma) and alleged accused (Koushik Mahato).

Meetings of 06.12.18 at 3:00 pm

After hearing from both complainant and alleged accused students, the members of the ICC Committee had taken the following resolution:

- a) The incident happened outside the college campus.
- b) Both complainant and alleged accused students stated the incident but it was contradictory.
- c) The complainant has demanded her safety and security from the alleged accused students and she has withdrawn her complaint.
- d) The alleged accused student has given his undertaking stating that he will obey discipline of the college.
- e) The ICC Committee considered their demands and recommended for dissolution of the matter.
- f) Both parties have given their undertakings.

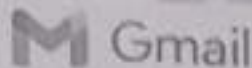

Advocate, 6 Associate Professors (Head of the Departments of Physics, History, Anthropology, Philosophy, Geography and Zoology) , One non-teaching member from Student's Section and one staff from Principal's Office.
2. One complaint had been lodged by Swagata Sharma, 1<sup>st</sup> Year English Honours student on 27.09.18 regarding physical assault against Kaushik Mahato, a student of 2<sup>nd</sup> Year Microbiology Honours of this College.
3. The incident takes place outside the college campus, but since the alleged accused is the current student of the college, the members of ICC decided to hear from both the complainant (Swagata Sharma) and alleged accused (Kaushik Mahato) and a meeting was conducted in Bidhannagar College on 06.12.18.
4. After hearing from both the complainant and alleged accused, the members of ICC had taken undertakings from both parties.
5. The complainant had demanded her safety and security. After getting assurance from committee and authority, she had withdrawn her complaint.
6. The alleged accused student had given his undertaking stating that he would obey the discipline of the college.
7. The ICC considered the case sensitively and firmly and recommended for dissolution of the matter.

Sir,

I had written to Delhi anti ragging cell prior to the incident and the teachers ~~are~~ and the anti-ragging cell of Bichonmages College had told me they would handle the matter. ~~The~~ ~~had~~ ~~report~~ Soornil Saha had repeatedly, despite me telling him to not to on several occasions forcefully carried me and dragged me; he would forcefully hold me and lift me up like a juggler. I had reported this to the Delhi anti ragging cell on the 10th of April 2022. Three different teachers had told him not to but he still kept at it. I was forced to take the matter to Delhi.

He had been bothering me for over a week. He had harassed others before me. He had physically hit a student, abused a professor and even abused a teacher and made a girl cry. I was repeatedly <sup>verbally</sup> abused by him. I often would try to avoid him but he would repeatedly find me. He interrupted me during a class test by walking onto

the class and kept disturbing me. I had told him to stay away. He kept calling me through different numbers and other people and bothering me.

On the 20th of April 2022, I was sitting and studying for my internal exams, which ~~were~~<sup>are</sup> on the 25th and 27th of this month. Since my exams are so close I didn't want to come to the college and study at home. I only came to collect ~~the~~ my marksheet. He then walked into my class and I saw him close to me and smiling. The door was closed but he opened it and walked in. I recall feeling ill and nauseous. I don't remember the incident clearly. The entire ~~event~~ incident was very traumatic so I don't remember it very well.

**OFFICE ORDER**

As per the advice of the Disciplinary Committee, the undersigned issued an order on 17.12.2022 prohibiting Sri Saurav Ghosh of Political Science, Sem-III from taking normal entry to the college without prior approval of the Principal. Also he was declared to be debarred from appearing the Internal Examination going to be started on and from 03.01.2023, vide memo no. 678/22 dated 17.12.2022.

All these actions were taken as disciplinary steps against Sri Saurav Ghosh as he did not comply with the order of the Principal and did not appear along with his guardian on 16.12.2022.

Sri Saurav Ghosh, however, wrote to the Principal on 19.12.2022 that he could not appear along with his guardian on 16.12.2022 because of illness of his guardian. But he could manage to get time to write this only after the disciplinary order under memo number 678/22 dated 17.12.2022 was issued against him. Not only that he did not bother to substantiate his guardian's illness with any medical certificate and requested the Principal to arrange a different date for appearing.


Whereas, Sri Saurav Ghosh could have given intimation of non-appearance on 16.12.2022 beforehand;
