


Celebration of International Mother Language Day was organised by the Cultural Committee and NSS Committee at Seminar Hall on February 21, 2023.










Annual Sports of the College (2022-2023) was held from 10.30 AM in the College Ground (small) on April 1, 2023.












Rabindra Jayanti was observed by Cultural committee at Seminar Hall from 2 PM on 4th May 2023.
