Note:

1. All candidates are required to appear in the Written Admission Test (WAT) in order to be considered for the 40% category. Otherwise their names will be deleted from the 40% category list. No request in this regard will be entertained in future under any circumstances.
2. Candidates are required to download the Admit Card for the WAT from the college admission portal and bring **two copies** of the same. One signed copy will be retained in the college (as a proof of the attendance of the candidate) and the other one will be returned to the candidate after signature by the invigilator, which is required to be produced by the candidate during physical verification of the documents. Candidates, failing to produce duly signed admit card during verification process, will not be considered for admission. **No candidates will be allowed to sit for the WAT without 2 copies of the admit card.**
3. Candidates will be allowed to enter into the college premises only 20 minutes prior to the commencement of the examination in each half. They are required to report in the respective examination hall (detailed list of seating arrangement will be displayed near the entrance and outside the hall) prior to the commencement of the examination as mentioned above. No candidates will be allowed to enter in the examination hall after the commencement of the examination. No candidates will be allowed to leave the hall / college before the closing time.
4. **No mobile phones or similar electronic devices will be allowed inside the examination hall.** Candidates should bring and take care of such gadgets at their own risk. College authority will not entertain any request in this regard. If any candidate is found using such devices, his / her candidature is liable to be cancelled instantly.
5. Candidates are required to mark the correct option (in the MCQ type Test Booklet) using black / blue ball point pen only. Answer should be marked clearly; otherwise it will be treated as wrong answer.
6. Marked Test booklets must be submitted to the invigilator before leaving the hall.
7. Candidates are advised to check the website regularly for updates, if any.
