### The duration of the course:

Duration shall be of two academic years and the examination for the M.A. degree in Education shall be held in four semesters. The duration of the semester shall be as follows:

- ➤ 1st Semester July- December
- 2nd Semester January -May
- > 3rd Semester July December
- 4th Semester January -May

### **Course layout:**

The course shall comprise a total credit of 92 (ninety-two) distributed over the four semesters. The courses shall be grouped as Departmental core courses, and Electives comprising of DSE, SEC & AECC and will carry credits according to the number of theoretical classes required, study hours and laboratory hours.

### 1. Brief history of the Department:

In 1984, the Government of West Bengal established Bidhannagar College in Salt Lake, Kolkata. The College was then under the University of Calcutta. In the year 2007, University of Calcutta gave Bidhannagar College the necessary permission to introduce Department of Education. However, thereafter, Bidhannagar College got affiliated to the West Bengal State University and thus the Department of Education initiated its journey in July 2009. The Department has since then offered B.A. Honours course in Education. After conducting the UG Course successfully for ten years the Department was privileged to introduce in 2019 the Post Graduate Course in Education having its affiliation to the West Bengal State University with the approved intake capacity of 15 (Fifteen) students. In 2023, the intake capacity has become 18(Eighteen). Beginning with the academic session 2019-20, four batches of students have successfully completed the Master Degree Course.

At present the Department of Education, Bidhannagar College has three classrooms and a Computer Lab. in its possession. Apart from a rich collection of books in the Central Library, the Department also has a well-stocked Departmental library. The number of sanctioned Teaching posts (WBES) is six (06). Out of which four (04) teaching posts are filled. There are three (03) Associate Professors and one (01) Assistant Professor in the Department.

The total intake capacity at PG being 18, the Teacher-student ratio is quite high in the Department. Invited Talks, Lectures and educational excursions, seminars are regular features of the Department. Besides, the students are also encouraged to participate in various Co-curricular activities, games-sports both in and outside the campus.

The Department of Education, Bidhannagar College aspires to create a student friendly environment as it believes that, "Education is the passport to future, for tomorrow belongs to those who prepare for it today" (Malcolm X).
